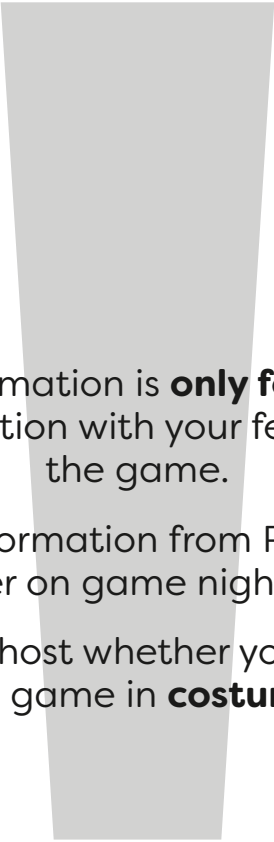

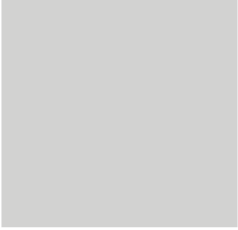




The following information is **only for you**. Don't share any of your information with your fellow players before the game.

## You are **Mary Jackson (19)**:

You grew up in India as the child of noble British parents and have only been living in America for a year. Your given name is Marietta Elizabeth Woodville. Your parents think you're studying in the USA and spending your holidays with your rich relatives in England. However, immediately after arriving in the states you met guru Maha Mallaya and joined his commune near San Francisco instead. He's the only one who's helped you understand yourself and the world. There's nothing else you need in life. You quickly fell madly in love with him. Was it because of your common connection with India or because of his wisdom and calm? Who knows? You can't imagine any better future than being together with him—and preferably in your home country of India. As much as you enjoy the spiritual consumption of LSD at the commune, you've found it difficult to embrace "free love." You only have eyes for Maha, but he shares his bed with several of the women. In particular, Lucy-Sue has been a thorn in your side. This tramp only flirts with the guru so that he'll supply her with drugs. You've tried everything you can to make Maha realize you're the true companion for him. Your commune regularly buys t-shirts to tie dye and sell at the local market in town. You always add some of your parent's money to the cash you collect to improve your sales tally. Of course, you hope this will impress Maha as well as make Lucy look bad with her low sales. So far, nobody in the commune knows about your wealthy noble parents. You don't want the others making fun of you. Instead, you told them you traveled extensively through India to learn about Buddhism—just like Maha Mallaya. After all, that's mostly true. To emphasize this common bond, you enjoy talking a lot about India and your experiences there.

In addition to selling tie dyed t-shirts, your main task is to care for the commune's animals. In India, your parents had dozens of elephants and white tigers, as well as a small herd of water buffalo. As a result, you learned a lot about handling animals. The commune only has a small chicken coop with 13 chickens, but you love each one as if it was your own child. Everyone is excited about the upcoming festival and with the early arrival of the band and security there's a lot more to do in the kitchen. However, you've been storing up provisions and already have a considerable supply of eggs. Unfortunately, the yield of fruit and vegetables has been disappointing. The site's soil isn't well suited to agriculture. Additional supplies for the guests have to be paid for with the t-shirt proceeds. It's a good thing you've been helping out there a little. The others were all at the Woodstock Festival shortly before you joined the commune, and the fantastic stories they tell always make you jealous. You hope the

commune's Woodstock revival will be even better so the guru will associate similar great stories with you in the future. The festival means a lot for the commune, so you hope the police won't try to evict everyone again. You'll certainly give it your all.

## **You did NOT kill Guru Maha Mallaya.**

You **may not lie** during the game. You may withhold information that incriminates you. If you are asked for something directly, you must tell the truth. Goal of the game: Find out who killed Maha Mallaya and their motive for doing so.

**Personal Goal:** You want to create more love and harmony in the world. Try to hug fellow players as often as possible during the game (including before or between rounds).

**Your appearance:** You mostly wear voluminous, floral-print dresses. You like to keep your hair in check with a practical head scarf. On special holidays you sometimes wear a sari from your home country and braid flowers in your hair. During your spare time in the commune, you've made some necklaces and bracelets that you like to wear. You usually keep your parent's money with you as it would be embarrassing to explain it if someone found it in the communal space.

## **Your feelings about the others:**

**Guru Maha Mallaya:** You love him more than anything. Even though he's a bit older, you hope he'll choose you as his sole companion. You can't imagine anything better in life and you're willing to give anything to get it.

**Stephanie "Stevie" Slick:** She's the lead singer for the band Joint Failure. You believe she needs lots of hugs. She's often very uptight and angry. And it makes sense because these concerts must be very stressful. You're happy such a big star is taking part in your festival.

**Jimmy Martin:** He's a totally cool rock star. You sometimes see him with the guru. Most likely, the guru is giving him spiritual advice.

**Wayne Lewis:** He's Stevie's brother and one of those men your father always warned you about. To be honest, he scares you. Fortunately, he's only here to provide security for the festival and will leave thereafter.

**Lucy-Sue Davis:** You really do love everyone, but you can't stand this phony snake in the grass. She's doing her best to take Maha Mallaya away from you. But she's messing around with the wrong woman. You'll show her!

**Bonnie Turner:** She and her husband are new to the commune. She's totally committed and is always checking in to make sure everything's going well with you! You don't fully understand her future plans yet. Maybe she can explain them to you when things are quieter.

**Richard "Dick" Turner:** You love the music he makes. Most of the time you don't understand Joint Failure's lyrics. However, Dick plays music written straight from the heart. Sometimes you can't decide whether to laugh or cry when you hear his songs. He's a genius!

**Michael Wright:** He's been in your commune for a long time, but you feel like he's become increasingly distant from you emotionally.

**Grace Anderson:** She's not as dark as she looks at all. She fed the chickens with you a few days ago and you've liked her since then.

**Charles Moore:** He's part of the motorcycle gang trying to find his way and you understand that. Before the guru showed you the way, you were a little lost yourself.
